Challenges to transitioning to organic and regenerative practices

Climate change is accelerating
Biodiversity is disappearing



animals and plant species
threatened with extinction



of soils moderately to severely
damaged

Farmers face challenges in transitioning
to organic and regenerative farming

- Inadequate infrastructure and financing
- Difficulty staying up to date with best practices
- Psychological barriers
- Lack of network

That's why in 2011 Danone Ecosystem joined forces with public and private partners to **empower farmers** and **assist their transition to organic farming and regenerative agriculture**

How it works



French farmers in Normandy

benefit from an initial consultation to understand what transitioning to organic and regenerative farming would imply



The next step is an in-depth consultation study to identify key levers in the transition

Knowledge

- Test innovative plot practices on farms: Yields, weediness, biodiversity, soil, costs, products / margin..
- Discover resilient, respectful & attractive farming systems: herd management, feed autonomy, low carbon footprint, animal care



Network

- Access to data and knowledge gleaned from two pilot farms that are exploring new, innovative organic and regenerative practices
- Connect with other farmers from Normandy and benefit from peer-to-peer knowledge



Test & learn approach

- Access to learning expeditions & farm visits to get inspired and test new practices
- Access to 2 pilot farms' learnings that are exploring new innovative organic & regenerative agriculture practices
- Benefit from an always adapting & evolving program

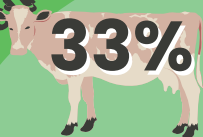

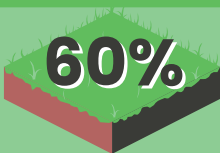
of Normandy-based organic dairy farmers **have transitioned to organic & regenerative farming** thanks to the program [as of 2019]
